We've come a long way since then, and Council is always looking to improve our aquatic facilities. We're investing heavily in state-of-the-art pools, and just this past Saturday, we opened a brand-new splash park in the heart of our City.

Across Sydney, there are impressive fountains and splash play areas, but this new splash park really is something else.

The free entry, all abilities Greenacre Splash Park is a first of its kind for our City and a huge new attraction for locals.

The kids will love the splash pad with Australia's first mega splash 4-dump bucket, water blasters and spray tunnels.

There's also a fantastic dry play area with slides, swings and trampolines. And for the parents, or just those wanting to make a day of it, there's a passive open space with family shelters and barbeque facilities.

The aquatic play areas will be supervised by our lifeguards during peak times, and the kiosk will be open to purchase a selection of foods.

Opening the Splash Park and seeing so many families and children running around and enjoying the features brought back a lot of fond memories.
